

Florida Standards Cheat Sheet

Science Example: SC.912.E.7.2

- **SC** = Science
 - **912** = Grades 9–12
 - **E** = Earth and Space Science (subdomain)
 - **7.2** = Standard 7, benchmark 2
 - **Full description:** *"Differentiate among the various forms of precipitation and describe the weather conditions associated with them."* (Note: This is a paraphrase — exact text is found in Florida's NGSSS)

Math Example: MA.912.GR.3.2

- **MA** = Mathematics
 - **912** = Grades 9–12
 - **GR** = Geometry and Reasoning
 - **3.2** = Standard 3, benchmark 2
 - **Full description:** *"Solve problems involving surface area and volume of three-dimensional figures."*

CTE Example: 8720300

- This is a **CTE (Career and Technical Education) course code**, not a benchmark.
- Example: 8720300 = "Introduction to Engineering Design" (under Florida DOE's Engineering & Technology Education track)
- These codes link to **course descriptions**, not individual standards. Each course has a set of performance standards aligned with it.

 **Social Studies / History Example: SS.912.A.1.4**

- **SS** = Social Studies
 - **912** = Grades 9–12
 - **A** = American History
 - **1.4** = Standard 1, benchmark 4
 - **Full description:** *"Analyze the validity, reliability, and bias of primary and secondary sources."*

 **Art Example: VA.912.C.1.2**

- **VA** = Visual Arts
- **912** = Grades 9–12
- **C** = Critical Thinking & Reflection
- **1.2** = Standard 1, benchmark 2
- **Full description:** *"Use critical thinking skills to assess and refine a piece of artwork."*
